

## Blaby Scouts Camp Kit List

**ALL** items taken to camp should be clearly labelled with your name. Anything left at the end of the camp that cannot be identified will be disposed of.

This is a 'standard' kit list. Please adjust according to expected weather, length of camp and planned activities.

**Sleeping bag** – this needs to be suitable for scout camping in a variety of conditions. 3 season one is ideal! No Black Bin Bags please. If the sleeping bag does not have a stuff sack, please use an old pillowcase.

**Karrimat & Blanket** – closed cell foam mat for insulation

**Bivvie Bag** – orange survival bag (Please ask if you don't have one, we have plenty!)

### **Clothing:**

Night wear

Underwear

Socks

T-shirts

Shorts/long trousers/joggers

Jumpers/sweatshirts

Warm fleece or similar

Anorak

Waterproof coat and trousers

Hat – to keep the head warm

Indoor shoes – A pair of trainers or crocs are ideal.

Walking boots or suitable shoes, and socks, for hiking & muddy conditions!

### **Poly bags for dirty clothes**

**Plus some cake please! Homemade is always nice!!**

### **Optional Items:**

Cuddly toy

Book/magazine

**Penknife** – Scouts are not permitted by the Scout Association to carry knives on their person. Any knife brought to camp must be handed in for safekeeping and will be issued for appropriate activities.

### **Items NOT Permitted:**

Denim jeans (when wet is uncomfortable & quickly leads to hypothermia), Mobile phones, Electronic games and Aerosols (including antiperspirants/deodorants)

**All kit** should be neatly packed in a rucksack or holdall **BY THE CAMPER!** Then THEY know what kit they have and will have a sporting chance of getting it ALL back in the bag!

Please do not tie items of loose kit to the main item. They all weave together in transit and are difficult to separate and unload!
